SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

In order to be eligible to apply for an ISIADA scholarship, you must be an immediate family member (including grandchildren) of a dealer principal or be an employee or immediate family member of an employee of a dealer principal. The dealership must be a current member of ISIADA in good standing for a minimum of one full year.

Every applicant must have a high school diploma or equivalent and must be pursuing higher education at a college, university, technical school, or trade school. Determination will be made on the following criteria: Financial need and educational goals as detailed in the required essay. GPA will be considered, but is not the sole determining factor. There is a lifetime limit of two scholarships per student.

In addition to the application, the following list of supporting documents must also be submitted:

- Recent transcript
- Letters of recommendation
- Essay about yourself, your reasons for applying for this scholarship, and your goals for the future
- Photograph with permission to use for promotional purposes
